			 No parents/carers are permitted to enter the school building and must return to the sports hall corridor at the end of the session to collect players. A letter will be sent to Parents/carers to ensure they adhere to the social distancing guidance of 2 meters while dropping off and collecting players. Each court will have a designated coach, they will monitor the players and ensure they are not interacting with other players on and off the court. Each court will have 2 benches, players are only allowed to sit on these benches with the designated coach for that court. All players and coaches will be informed that there will be no access to the changing rooms for any reason. Anyone using the toilet facility will be instructed to wash their hands before and after and to wipe touch points with appropriate disinfectant cleaner when leaving the toilet area.
